














A. Overview of My Progress Block

The Progress Report block provides STUDENTS with an overview of their progress in regards to activities in a given course. **This block is not shown to teachers.** Each line also acts as a link which provides students with a list of the relevant activities (example: when a student clicks on **X Incomplete** activities, his/her incomplete activities will get listed). This block is meant to work with the [Tabs Course format](#), but it can also be used on it's own.

Note 1: This block will report on activities that have the Activity Completion setting enabled. Activities that do not have the “completion tracking” turned on will not be included in this block. In the setting page for the assignment activity, for example, the activity completion section looks like this:

Note 2: As described above, if an activity has a “Require Grade” condition in the Grade setting, then that activity will show as “complete” when it receives **any** grade. However, if the same activity also has the “grade to pass” option enabled, as shown below, and it receives a grade less than the “grade to pass” value, the activity will be counted as “Completed - unsuccessful”.
