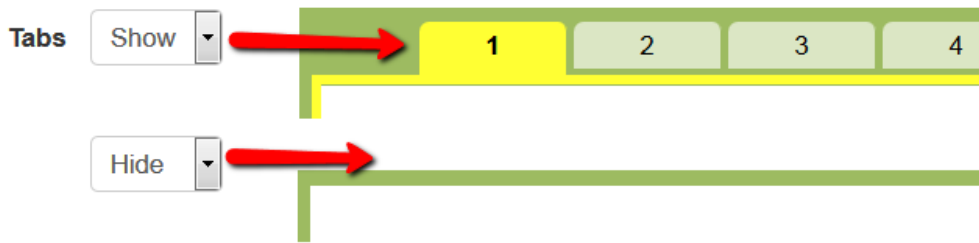

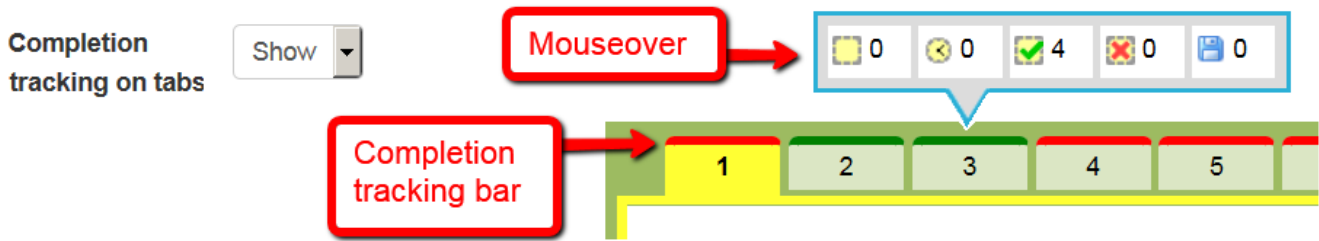

B: Tabs option

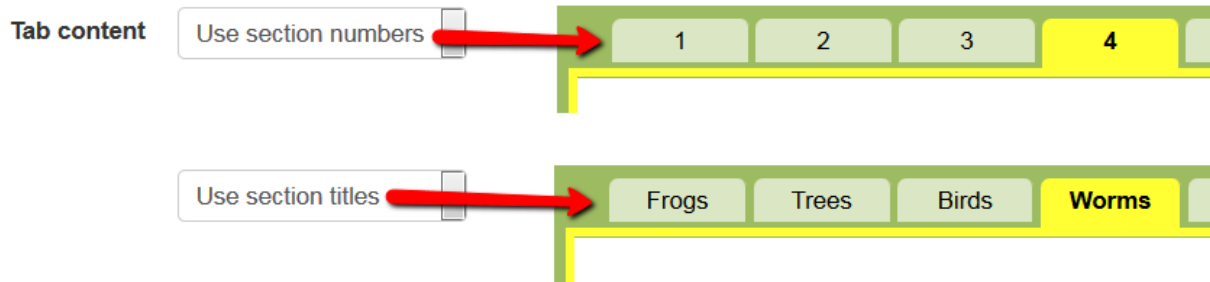
When turn on, a blue or green bar is shown on the top part of each tab. Blue colour indicates that all activities (with completion tracking) in that section have been completed. Red colour indicates that at least one activity remains incomplete. When the mouse is hovered over a tab, a “tooltip” is shown which indicates the status of the activities in that section. Note that only students can see this feature.



C & D: Headings

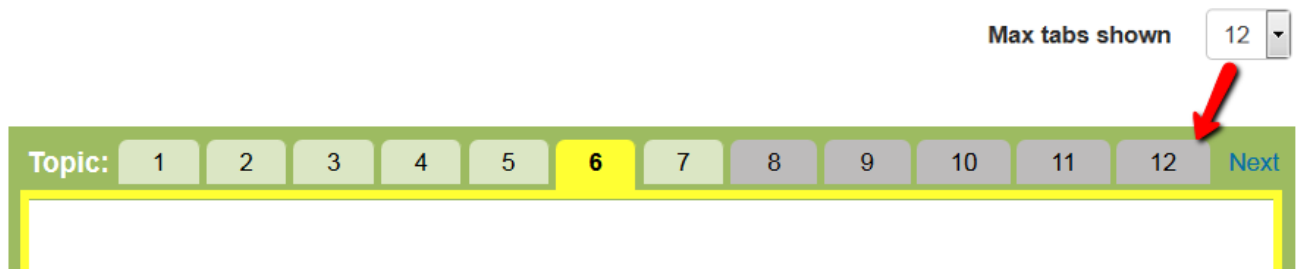


E: Tab content:
